Impact 2020-21



Our delivery

Despite COVID-19 Team Domenica has still achieved:

- All candidates on Supported Internships before COVID-19 are now back in external work placements.
- Just 2 candidates have lost employment.
- 11/11 furloughed candidates are now back at work with our support.
- We have had over 90% attendance.
- **0** drop-outs.
- Each candidate has received **120 hours** of virtual sessions, **170 hours** of classroom time, **170 hours** of enrichment and wellbeing support and **170 hours** of café training.*

*Normally 240 hours each



These results are very much the leading edge of our impact. There are so many individual stories in our community where Team Domenica is playing a central part in change; from our candidates and their families, to the changing landscape of employment and policy in our area.

It has been a very challenging year for all, but Team Domenica is poised to increase our impact and reach in 2021-22.





Candidate stories

Before Josh joined Team Domenica, his parents were convinced that his autism, communication difficulties and anxiety would mean that his dream to work in the catering industry would never become a reality. He completed educational modules, which helped him to develop his communication skills, along with practical skills such as money-handling. Our enrichment activities allowed him to gain confidence, develop social skills, build strong friendships – and even meet his girlfriend, Frankie! But it was putting his new skills into practise in Café Domenica that his passion for catering really shone through.

Team Domenica was able to match Josh to a supported internship with Jurys Inn. Josh's Job Coach worked with him to manage his anxiety using his love of rules and his role was adjusted to focus on tasks where his autism helped him to excel. We provided training for the Jury's Inn team. Less than a year from when he first stepped foot in the hotel, Josh was offered paid employment at Jurys Inn! Then just a few months later, Josh was nominated for the Most Outstanding Person Award at the Brighton and Hove Hotelier Awards – and he won!
